Many inquiries and requests come before the DRC asking about "art" in the landscape. The DRC allows decorative elements within patio or courtyard walls, but not on top of, or in front of walls. If there is no courtyard wall, the committee allows art in the area between the front door and the closest corner of the house to the front door.

The reasons for this are that "art is in the eyes of the beholder'. What may be attractive to one homeowner may not be considered attractive by others in the neighborhood. The committee applies the term "art" to pots as well. A beautifully planted and maintained pot is a wonder to behold. A pot full of dead vegetation becomes a neighborhood eyesore.
